Bucharest Running Club announces that traffic will be closed, for all vehicles, on Saturday, October 4th and Sunday, October 5th, on all the city's streets that are going to be used for the Raiffeisen Bank Bucharest International Marathon 7th edition.

Saturday, October 4th (8AM – 2PM): Bd. Unirii (between Piata Unirii and Piata Constitutiei).

Sunday, October 5th (6.30AM – 4PM): Bd. libertatii, Bd. Unirii, Bd. Decebal, Bd. Basarabia (up to Bd. Chisinau), National Arena area, Bd. Natiunile Unite, Str. Halelor, Splaiul Independentei (from Piata Unirii to Str. Stirbei Voda), Piata Unirii, Calea Victoriei (from Splaiul Independentei to Str. Ion Campineanu).

Note: public transportation intersecting above mentioned streets will follow addapted routes.
