



SportAccord primește sprijin continuu din partea asociațiilor europene și mondiale de loterie și recunoaște rolul esențial al loteriilor naționale în sponsorizarea sportului, în special activităților de baza.

Acest parteneriat istoric datează din 2011 și este orientat spre eforturilor de educație.

The first key achievement consisted of the development of an online educational program called [RealPlayer](#). Next steps include the linkage of this educational tool to a certification platform allowing participants to follow different types of integrity programs and get certified. This online educational approach has been successfully tested in 2013 during the SportAccord World Combat Games and the SportAccord World Mind Games.

The development of national educational workshops held in the European Union has also been possible due to the support of the two lottery associations. During the 2014 edition of the World Lottery Summit held in Rome in early November, SportAccord participated in the panel on Sports Integrity and emphasized the strong will to continue these successful national seminars on a global scale throughout Europe, and also in Asia and other countries. This educational approach shall also target SportAccord members, the international federations, to work on prevention policies with IF sports administrators.

SportAccord and the Lotteries will meet in Sochi in April 2015 during the [SportAccord Convention](#) - World Sport and Business Summit to envision the continuation of this fruitful cooperation.
