Williams leads Halep in their head-to-head series, 4-1, but their two meetings at the BNP Paribas WTA Finals Singapore presented by SC Global

last year are perhaps the most relevant - Halep beat Williams in the round robin, 6-0, 6-2, the equal-worst loss of Williams' career in terms of games won, but the American rebounded in a big way when they met again in the final a few days later, 6-3, 6-0.

"Serena is Serena. She's No.1 in the world. She's very strong," Halep said.

"It was a big day for me when I beat her. The biggest day, let's say. I learned that if I have the courage to go on court and just think I can win it, I can do it. If I'm nervous and I have emotions, it's much more difficult to play against her. You just have to believe and try your best, and try everything to win."
